


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Message from Administration

Allergy Awareness



We want to remind all parents that CCA is a 'Allergy aware' facility.

Please be advised that a number of our learners and staff are allergic to nuts. As such, food and treats containing nuts should never be brought to school. When a student realizes they have accidentally bought an item containing nuts, they simply need to bring it to the attention of the teacher who can assist.

Thank you for your cooperation in keeping the school safe for all members of our learning community.

Food and Treats



Parents are invited to send **store-bought, individually pre-packaged food and treats** to school with their child for such events as birthdays and special classroom celebrations (please consult your child's teacher for specific classroom routines).

All food sent to school to be shared with the class **must be commercially packaged.** This means such items as cake, cupcakes, and cookies baked and packaged at home (wrapped with cellophane) are not permitted.

In addition, all packaged items must be labelled 'NUT FREE'. If baked at home or not labelled 'nut free,' the food will be returned home with the child who brought it to school.

Welcome Back RVS



At RVS we work hard to share information about what is happening in your child's classroom, at the school and across the division. This communication comes in many forms – classroom emails, parent/teacher conferences, school newsletters, websites, social media, division letters and more. RVS teachers, school and division staff aim to provide you with the most relevant information. We encourage you to please take time to read it. Our school and division websites are a great resource for additional information and to answer questions you may have – please check them often for updates.

There are times when you may need more specific information about your child, which could be in an email, phone call or meeting depending on the question or situation. We welcome ongoing dialogue with families.

We ask for your patience and understanding in how and when a teacher or administrator responds. Most of their days are spent in front of students focussed on their learning. When they are not in the

classroom, they are preparing for the next day, reviewing assignments or getting home to their families and they might not be able to return your call or email that day. Under normal circumstances, school staff will respond to emails within 24 hours on school days (not after 6 p.m.) or by the end of the following workday if received on the weekend/holiday. Across all of RVS, we do not expect school staff/teachers to read or respond to emails after 6pm on school days or on weekends/holidays. This common expectation across all our schools and is described in administrative procedure 145⁵ which is linked to here.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding. Together, we can create a supportive environment that benefits our students' learning and growth.
